Invitation to Comment on RSPO Certification Assessment of New Britain Palm Oil Limited operations at West New Britain, Papua New Guinea.

New Britain Palm Oil Limited (NBPOL), a wholly owned subsidiary of Kulim Malaysia Berhad, has applied to BSi Management Systems Singapore Pte Ltd for RSPO Certification of its palm oil production. NBPOL owns and operates 4 palm oil mills, 25 oil palm plantations, a palm oil refinery, and an oil palm seed production unit. NBPOL purchases oil palm fruit from approximately 7,000 smallholders for processing at its mills. NBPOL aims to achieve RSPO Certified Sustainable Palm Oil during 2008 for all of the production from the company managed plantations. NBPOL has started implementing a 3-year plan to achieve Certification of its smallholder supply base.

NBPOL is a foundation member of RSPO and has taken a leading role in the Roundtable process from inception, including participation in RSPO technical working groups, trial implementation of the P&Cs, development of a self-assessment tool, coordination of the PNG NIWG and reporting on its progress at each of the RSPO International Conferences.

BSi plans to carry out Certification Assessment of NBPOL, comprising oil mills, company managed plantations, refinery and associated support infrastructure during the week commencing 31 March 2008, subject to RSPO approval of the Papua New Guinea NIWG Indicators. The Assessment process will involve an audit of the NBPOL operations by a team of BSi Environmental and Social Auditors, as well as meetings at local communities where NGOs operating in the area and other stakeholders will have opportunity to provide input to the process.

In preparation for this process, stakeholders also are invited to provide written input to the Assessment by commenting on any environmental or social aspect of NBPOL's performance that you consider may be relevant to this assessment.

Suggested topics that you may wish to comment on are as follows:

- Environmental protection
- Biodiversity conservation
- Opportunities for employment
- Company approach to community development
- Your relationship with the company
- Participation in decision making
- Free, prior and informed consent
- Suggestions for improvement
